

ATHLETE COMPETITION INFORMATION

GENERAL

Welcome to the Boysen Memorial, an international athletic meet held at Bislett Stadium in Oslo, Norway.

The 2026 edition will take place on Wednesday June 24th and is part of the World Athletics Continental Tour Bronze. The Boysen Memorial is one of Norway's premier athletics meetings, attracting both national and international athletes across track and field events.

TRANSPORTATION

- Oslo Lufthavn Gardermoen (OSL) → Train from (OSL) to Oslo for 20 minutes
- Torp Sandefjord Airport (TRF) → Train from (TRF) to Oslo for 1 hour and 30 minutes

Transportation support and travel reimbursements are handled according to agreements with the organizer. Athletes are encouraged to use public transportation and trains whenever possible as part of the event sustainability initiative. Covered athletes will receive train tickets through WhatsApp closer to arrival date. Reimbursement of travel receipts must be sent to the organizer after the meet.

HOTEL

Like previous editions, for invited and confirmed athletes we can offer full board accommodation 2 nights (June 23rd-25th) at the official hotel, **Scandic Solli – Oslo**. Other participating athletes are encouraged to book early to secure availability. A discounted rate is available using the booking code: **D000025231**. Athletes are responsible for confirming accommodation arrangements directly with the organizer.

At hotel arrival athletes will be provided with an envelope at the check-in counter. The envelope provides the athlete with two meal vouchers, two bus tickets, and accreditation.

Directions from airport to Hotel: Take the train from the airport and get off at station name "Nationaltheateret". Walk for 5 minutes to the hotel.

MEALS

For invited and accommodated athletes, breakfast will be served at the hotel according to the hotel opening hours. Lunch and dinner will be provided with two meal vouchers (Dinner Tuesday and Lunch Wednesday). The vouchers will be distributed at welcome material at hotel arrival. Any additional food or beverages beyond these specified meals will be at your own expense .

For all athletes competing, there will be offered a BBQ dinner at the top of the stadium (Seb Coe) Wednesday evening. Everyone is offered 1 portion of free dinner.

CALL ROOM, BIB PICKUP, ATHLETE SUPPORT

Entry to the stadium will find place by “Adgang2” at Bislett Stadium. Call room, bib pickup, and athlete support will be located at the indoor track under the stands (find map at the end of this document). In the Call Room officials will check bib numbers, shoes, spikes, and athlete uniforms according to World Athletics rules. Unauthorized electronic devices are not permitted in the competition area.

Bib pickups take place Wednesday, June 24th, from 3pm up to 90 minutes before event starts. Athletes will receive an email for final confirmation of participation the day before. If you have trouble with the link, you can confirm your participation at our “athlete support” 90 minutes before competition.

Call room table and schedule of events will be published closer to the event date on the official Boysen Memorial website.

FIELD EVENTS

In all throwing events each Athlete is allowed to three practice trials under the supervision of the judges, more if time allows. In the remaining field events, the practice trials will be supervised by the relevant judges. The Athletes will be called to the practice trials in the competition order.

WARMUP- FLOW

Warm-up facilities are available around Bislett Stadium and in designated indoor areas. Athletes are asked to follow instructions from volunteers and officials regarding warm-up flow and access areas.

COACHING ZONES

Special coaching areas will be available near selected field events including Throwing and Jumps. Coaches are offered an accreditation ticket to get into the stadium. One ticket per athlete.

EQUIPMENT CONTROL

Personal throwing equipment shall be delivered to the Equipment Control Room at least 60 minutes before starting time of the relevant event. The Equipment Control Room will be located in the same room as Athlete support.

TRAINING TUESDAY JUNE 23RD

There will be organized training on Tuesday, June 23rd from 3:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Training will also be available on Wednesday morning, June 24th. For all events, the training will take place at the competition venue.

If international athletes are in need for a weight room Tuesday 23rd, we offer a gym in the basement of our office at IK Tjalve. In order to take use of this, please plan ahead and reach out to Thea Alsaker (thea@tjalve.no / +47 406 25 254)

TRANSPORT HOTEL to BISLETT STADIUM

There goes a bus named “21 Helsefyrt” from Solli to Bislett Stadium and back named “21 Tjuvholmen”, departure every 7th minutes. Covered athletes will receive two 24-h transportation tickets in their envelope upon hotel arrival. To activate the ticket, you scan it on the bus. Athletes are encouraged to use public transportation whenever possible as part of the event sustainability initiative.

For non-covered athletes, we recommend downloading [Ruter](#) to purchase and activate tickets for public transportation within Oslo.

PRICE MONEY

Prize money will be awarded according to the meeting’s official prize structure.

Boysen Award – 800 m

An additional performance bonus will be awarded for outstanding results:

- Men: Sub 1:45.90
- Women: Sub 2:01.00

Bonus: 10,000 NOK (approx €1,000)

Tax rate in Norway is 15% which will be deducted from the prize money.

The LOC will contact prize money recipients after the meeting regarding payment. Payment of prize money, and prior agreed upon travel fees, will be done by invoice from your agency, club or federation, and must be properly marked with IBAN, Swift/BIC and account owner. There is no tax deduction when paid to agency/club/federation.

If you have no way of getting an organisation to invoice for you, let us know after the meeting. We will then need to do a direct payment to the athlete with a 15% tax deduction.

PRIZE CEREMONY

The prize ceremony will take place on the infields of the track. The announcer will announce over the speakers when to meet for the ceremony as we do a rolling schedule.
